Thompson. Motion passed. In the fourth set, Charles Waterman faced off in Forest Grove

School Board, Position 2 against a Democrat who did not respond to the committee. Moved

Position 7. Moved and seconded to accept the committee's recommendation to endorse Tom

Colett. Motion passed. In the sixth set, moved and seconded to suspend the 180-day rule for

Mark Watson running for Hillsboro School Board, Position 2. Motion passed. Moved and

seconded to endorse Mark Watson. Motion passed. In the final set, Kevin Currin Smith, Brian

Lyles, and Jaci Spross faced off for Hillsboro School District, Position 6. Moved and seconded

to accept the committee's recommendation of Jaci Spross for endorsement. Motion passed.

of No Cause Evictions; Re. Relating to The Oregon Legislature's Ability to Raise Revenue with

a Simple Majority; and In Support of Requiring Presidential Candidates to Release Tax Returns.
