1. Meeting Opened at 7:00 pm

○ The Chair explained Special Meeting requirements and explained the importance of the CC membership vote on the Endorsements Committee's recommendations for candidate endorsements tonight instead of waiting until the March 27th regular CC meeting to enable the candidates to meet their printing deadlines for slate cards. A prior email survey was conducted indicating that there was majority support for the Special Meeting. The regular March CC meeting will be next Wed., 3/27/19.

Members entered into discussion.

- Louise Currin made a motion to amend the motion to 3 minutes each.

Vote was taken to have candidates answer questions; Vote - motion did not pass.

- Jaime Rodriguez - made a motion to end debate - Motion passed
- Chair - stated the motion was to substitute the main motion to be a dual endorsement. Results of Vote: 50 yes and 39 no votes.

Motion passed to endorse candidates as dual-endorsed candidates.
