

Active CC Motions - 2019

Motions made at the CC with an ongoing effect (excluding rules and public policy resolutions)

Special Committee on Gender/Non-Binary Issues

March 27, 2019

Move to create a special committee of 5 members to be nominated in April by the Chair to review the delegate election rules used at the 2018 Organizational Meeting and how they were implemented, and to review related matters as necessary to make recommendations to the Central Committee of Rules and Procedures that best insure all party elections are conducted fairly and inclusively, especially in respect to gender identity.

The motion was adopted.

April 24, 2019

Chrissy Erguiza, Shabba Woodley, Barbara Glazer, and Garrett Fleenor were nominated by the Chair to be part of the special committee and approved by the CC. The Chair asked permission of the body to nominate the 5th member in May and the CC approved the request.

May 22, 2019

Dan Franks was nominated by the Chair to be part of the special committee and approved by the CC.

Instruction to Resolutions & Platform Committee - Limit Resolutions

May 22, 2019

Move to instruct the Resolutions and Platform Committee to report no more than two items each month to the Central Committee for the remainder of 2019.

The motion was adopted.

Instruction to Rules Committee - Limit Rules Amendments

May 22, 2019

Instruct the Rules Committee to bring forward new bylaw and rules proposals to the Central Committee no more than twice per year over the next twelve months.

The motion was adopted.

Investigation Special Committee - SCC Delegate in question

May 22, 2019

Move to create a special committee to investigate the conduct and actions of SCC alternate delegate Keith Haxton at the standing committee meetings, caucus meetings, and SCC business meeting on May 19, 2019. The committee is to report back with its findings by the July 2019 to the Washington County CC meeting. The Chair shall appoint the members of the Special Committee.

The motion was adopted.

Investigation Special Committee - SCC Delegate conduct

June 26, 2019

Move to add additional instructions to the special committee to investigate the conduct and actions of SCC delegates at the standing committee meetings, caucus meetings, and SCC business meeting on May 19, 2019. The committee is to report back with its findings by the August 2019 to the Washington County CC meeting.
