This regular monthly meeting of the Democratic Central Committee is held virtually via the Zoom platform. A meeting is held on the fourth Wednesday of each month, except in November and December.

Chair Report

Per our March Central Committee meeting we voted to leave some of the contribution fund open so that the executive board could commit to providing in real time to those who needed more funds.

Since then, the executive board met and felt that the Hillsboro races and Sherwood races were the most critical and would need more attention and help.

The Washington County Democrats donated \$700 to Patrick Maguire, \$700 to Ivette Pantoja and \$700 to See Eun Kim in order to help them fund their campaign manager for the remainder of the campaign. A campaign manager was critical for them to run a coordinated slate, and they are excited for this edition to their team and feel it will be critical to their races.

Total extra donated to Hillsboro: \$2,100

I had conversations with both Hans Moller and Matthew Thornton's campaign, and as Matthew

Thornton has a more complex campaign (that is also benefiting Hans), we are also donating \$795 additional dollars to help them pay for their mailer.

We have also used the small remainder of funds for additional slate cards for the neighborhood leader program as was requested from Sherwood*, as well as the overage cost of stamps that were necessary for the neighborhood leader program.

*I want to give a special shout out to Mike Hiland, the house district leader in Sherwood. He is going for and beyond the duties of a house district leader and doing a thousand postcard mailer campaign of our slate cards to reach as many Democrats as possible in Sherwood!
