- Democrats on an NLP List increased their turnout by 8.6 percentage points (~30% increase) over the average registered Democrat in Washington County
- Voters who actually talked to a Neighborhood Leader more than doubled the county average turnout rate (53.5% vs. 21.7%). Face-to-face contact is the #1 most effective organizing tool.
- Postcards have a slightly lower effect than not-home door knocks (35.2% vs. 37.4%)
